Minority/Women Business Enterprise Policy

Adopted: Nov. 2017

It is the policy of the Claverack Free Library to ensure that minority business enterprises (MBEs), i.e., independent business concerns which are at least 51 percent owned and controlled by minority group members who are Black, Hispanic, Asian, or American Indian, and women-owned business enterprises (WBEs), i.e., independent business concerns which are at least 51 percent owned and controlled by a women, are given the opportunity to demonstrate their ability to provide the Library with goods and services at competitive prices..

The statement for inclusion in all Claverack Free Library requests for quotations, bid proposals, and contract documents shall be as follows:

“It is the policy of the Claverack Free Library to ensure that minority- and women-owned business enterprises are given the opportunity to demonstrate their ability to provide the Library with goods and services at competitive prices.”
